IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR PARENTS

NEW SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2011-2012

The California Department of Public Health would like you to know that whooping cough, a very serious illness also known as pertussis is widespread in California.

For the 2011-12 school year, a new law now requires that all incoming 7th-12th graders get a whooping cough booster shot, called Tdap, before entering school. This shot is routinely recommended for children ages 10 and older.

In order for your student (entering grades 7 and 8) to get their Fall 2011 Class Schedule, you will be required to provide proof of the Tdap booster (immunization record with Tdap date verified by health care provider) to the school office. Please submit this documentation as soon as possible, preferably no later than Friday, May 13, 2011. We have provided a form for you to take to your health care provider on the reverse of this notice.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The following California State mandated whooping cough booster shot, called Tdap, is required for all 7th-8th grade students for the 2011-2012 school year. Please submit the following records to your school office by Friday, May 13th. The Tdap booster MUST be completed before the start of the 2011-2012 school year in order for your child to continue in school.

New Required Immunization:

All records must give a date and be signed or stamped by your doctor's office. Your immunization records must give a date for all immunizations required. We have provided a space below for your health care provider to complete.
